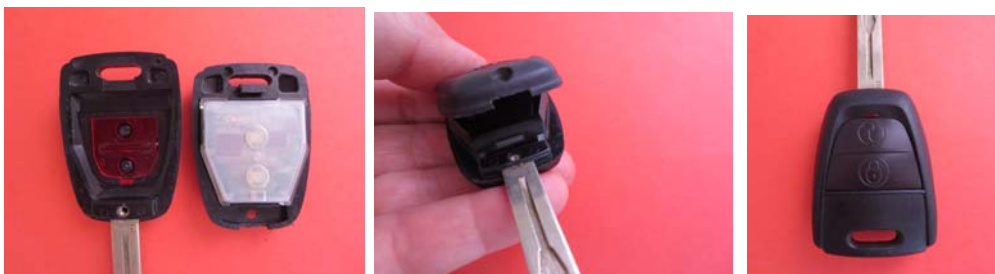
You are replacing worn buttons cover in Kia remote with Silicone Replacement Pad from POLMEX. Our pads are made form high purity LSR Silicone and will not: deform, change shape, become brittle and break unlike original cover. It is a great fix at a fraction of the price of new remote and re-programming.



Unscrew small screw at the back of plastic shell. Prase open remote placing your fingernail in the small cut out located at the key shaft end. Separate all parts: top hard shell part with button key pad with electronic board and back part of the shell.



Next separate electronic component from the top part of plastic shell. Remove old key button pad and separate red see thru plastic cover from the back of it. Red plastic cover will be re fitted later on. To fit our new Silicone first place red see thru plastic cover inside new Silicone key button pad.



Next fit assembled key buttons and red plate in the top part of your remote. Once key buttons are in, you will place electronic component over the top part of the shell. Next you can cover it with bottom part of the hard shell. If all components sit in correctly you can close remote by firm pressing and screw to pieces together. Your refurbished remote should look like the one in the picture above. **No re-programming is need it.**
