### Button Replacement Procedure



1. To open remote you have to unscrew small screw on the back of the remote with Phillips screwdriver.



2. Gently separate remote into 2 pieces by opening it along **hinged end** located at the bottom of remote.



3. Remove old rubber button from electronic switch lifting it up gently with tip of the finger.



4. Press fit new Silicone button in till it engages with the hard shell of remote.



5. Once button fitted in put remote together in reverse order. Close both parts of the shell and screw it together.

Once button replacement is finished, remote will work straight away with **no need for re-programming.**
